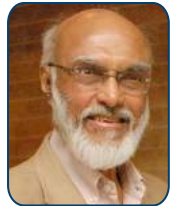

GUJARAT MAHATMA GANDHI ELOCUTION TROPHY COMPETITION (FEBRUARY 21ST, 2023):

- HLCC organized the prestigious Gujarat Mahatma Gandhi Elocution Trophy Competition, focusing on the theme "In the present-day context of the growing religious divide in India and the world over, Gandhian idea of religious equality (Sarva Dharma Sambhav) is the only remedy to usher harmony in the society." Twenty teams, comprising a total of 40 students from various colleges and universities, enthusiastically participated in this intellectually stimulating event.
- The panel of judges included distinguished personalities such as Prof Kaivalya Baxi, Advocate at Gujarat High Court, Dr. Amarinder Pandey from Gujarat Vidyapith, and Prof Achala Patel, who brought their expertise to evaluate the participants' speeches objectively.
- HLCC was represented by Moksha Maheshwari and Rohan Shewkani, who eloquently presented their perspectives on the theme. Moksha's exceptional oratory skills earned her the prestigious 3rd individual prize, showcasing the college's commitment to nurturing public speaking talents.
- The competition witnessed remarkable performances from participants across institutions. Prisha Bansal from GLS University was honored with the Best Speaker prize, while Vaishnavi Oza from L. D. Arts College secured the second prize, highlighting the caliber of speakers at the event.

- Ultimately, the trophy was lifted by the team of debaters from Ahmedabad University, underscoring the spirit of healthy competition and camaraderie among participating institutions. The Gujarat Mahatma Gandhi Elocution Trophy Competition served as a platform for meaningful discourse and reflection on Gandhian ideals in contemporary society.

YOUTH FESTIVAL:

HLCC students showcased their diverse talents and emerged victorious in various competitions:

- **J G College of Physiotherapy Youth Festival (September 17th & 18th, 2023):** A total of 86 students from HLCC participated in the Youth Festival, competing in 26 different items. The college students excelled in 15 items, including Folk Dance, Debate, Mimicry, One-Act-Play, Collage, and Dance, demonstrating their multifaceted abilities and commitment to excellence.
- **Representation at Youth Festival West-Zone (January 23rd & 24th, 2024):** Moksha Maheshwari and Vedant Bhavsar represented Gujarat University at the Youth Festival West-Zone held at Rashtra Sant Tukadoji Maharaj University, Nagpur. They showcased their debating skills, reflecting the college's emphasis on holistic development and academic prowess.

GANDHI-KING SCHOLARLY EXCHANGE INITIATIVE:

One of our esteemed B.Com Semester 4 students, Ishan Khetan, has been selected for the prestigious Gandhi-King Scholarly Exchange Initiative, generously funded by the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs USA. The initiative is designed to foster collaboration between young leaders from the United States and India, with a focus on advancing civil

rights, social justice, and inclusion at local, national, and global levels. By delving into the rich legacies of Mahatma Gandhi and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., participants are inspired to work toward positive societal change.

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- The exchange program selected 10 students each from both the United States and India. It commenced with a one-week virtual program and orientation held from June 15 to June 22, 2022. Following this, participants embarked on a two-week academic residency at Alabama A&M University, spanning from June 25 to July 9, 2022. The culmination of the program featured an immersive experiential learning journey in India, conducted from January 1 to January 15, 2023.



Another standout participant from our institution, Ms. Moksha Maheshwari, was also chosen for this prestigious program. This international endeavor includes a week-long virtual program and orientation, featuring synchronous (live) and asynchronous activities. Subsequently, all participants engage in a two-week program in the USA, followed by a two-week experiential program in India. These immersive experiences aim to cultivate global perspectives and leadership qualities among the participants, empowering them to enact meaningful change in their communities and beyond.

THEATRE CLUB WORKSHOP: A theatre workshop was organized in August 2023, providing students with opportunities for artistic expression and skill development.

INNOVATION CLUB INITIATIVES:

- **Online Training on Vernacular Innovation (January 17th, 2023, to February 7th, 2023):** Five students participated in a 15-day, 30-hour online training program titled "Basics of Vernacular Innovation" on the Amrut Navsarjan platform. The training focused on teaching the fundamentals of block coding, enabling participants to create animations and develop games.
- **DIY Mechanical Kit Repair Program (January 30th, 2023):** Eleven students from the Innovation Club actively participated in a program utilizing a DIY Mechanical Kit to conduct repair works within the college premises. Utilizing instruments from the kit, the students successfully repaired a whiteboard and a soft board in different classrooms. This hands-on activity provided practical experience to the students in conducting small repair activities independently.

- **Project Development - Water Alarm (February 4th, 2023):** Seven students from the TY class of the Innovation Club collaborated to develop a project titled "Water Alarm" using an Electronics kit. Employing components such as breadboards, jumper wires, resistors, LEDs, buzzers, and batteries, the students designed a water alarm system. This system featured LEDs lighting up progressively as the water level increased, with the buzzer activating upon reaching a specific level.



HLCC MOCK MUN 2023 :

- The 9th edition of HLCC MOCK MUN took place on February 4th, 2023, welcoming approximately 363 delegates from 5th standard and above. Renowned as the most prestigious and enduring Model United Nations (MUN) event in Gujarat since 2013, HLCC MUN is dedicated to offering a comprehensive learning platform for youth.
- The conference, spanning 6 hours from 11 AM to 4:30 PM, featured lively debates and discussions among delegates in their respective committees. Distinguished Executive Board members, known for their expertise and experience, were invited to oversee proceedings. Attendees were treated to a sumptuous lunch and high tea, meticulously arranged with emphasis on hygiene and cleanliness.
- The event concluded with a closing ceremony, marked by an introductory address from Professor Hervez Bharucha, followed by the distribution of certificates and trophies to outstanding delegates across various categories. A feedback wall was set up to gather attendees' reviews on the event and services provided.
- Led by Dr. Radha Tiwari, the organizing committee comprised 19 dedicated members, including 17 from the second year and 2 from the first year. The Advisory Board, consisting of 8 third-year students and 1 M. Com student, played a crucial role in guiding the event's execution. - The Closing Ceremony, marked by the Lok Sabha Panelist Dr. Kirit Solanki's enlightening presence, crowned the event with prize distributions, leaving delegates inspired and ready for the next decade of MUN excellence. This hands-on exposure allowed students to gain practical knowledge and understanding of real-world business operations.

- In collaboration with IMS, HL College of Commerce organized an insightful masterclass on innovation and creativity in business, featuring Mr. Kartik Shah as the expert speaker, focusing on "new age career options in management," held on January 11th, 2023.

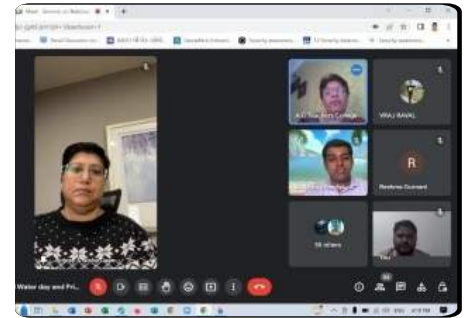


ALUMNI ACHIEVEMENTS
