

REPORT ON TWO DAY WORKSHOP

"Research Methodology for Pure and Applied Sciences" $23^{rd}-24^{th}\ December,\ 2022$

Botany Department, under the aegis of IQAC, M.G Science Institute, Ahmedabad, organized a two day workshop on "Research Methodology for pure and applied sciences" on 23 & 24th December 2022, in the college auditorium. The resource person was the renowned Professor and Researcher, Prof. Sunil Dutta Purohit from Mohanlal Sukhadia University Udaipur, Rajasthan. Prof. S.D.Purohit formerly served as Head, Dept. of Botany, MS Uni., Udaipur and is a part of International phytoessence consortium, USA; Senior Editor, IJPNI, USA; etc.

Ninety seven participants (thirty six teachers) from various AES run institutions in Ahmedabad participated. Along with MGSI, there were participants from L.M Pharmacy College and H.L Commerce College. In the Inaugural, Dr. Alpana Shukla welcomed our Speaker along with all the guests and the faculty members and research scholars. She highlighted the activities of IQAC. The speaker provided clear vision and encouraged all to grow up with ideas and start working towards the same. At last a small activity was provided to find the mistakes in the given research papers and participants were taught editing.
